SEVERN SHORE rated a short lead off the rail, was driven from the head of the lane, drifted to the outside in the upper stretch but held on well when straightened away. CAPE'S COURAGE rated just off the pace inside, bid nearing the quarter pole, drifted outward leaving the final turn and finished well but had to settle for second best. CITY SPIN settled back from the early pace about the three path, bid from the five sixteenths pole, eased to the five path entering the stretch and was along for show. WHAT A GIFT, five wide into the first turn, stalked the winner two deep, gave chase from the three eighths pole though had nothing left in the stretch. OLI RAVIOLI, well back inside, gave chase leaving the first turn, improved to the head of the lane but had little left from there. LA CHUPACABRA was kept close to the early pace toward mid track then faded nearing the final turn. CRAFTY MARY, off the pace toward mid track, was not a factor. MARY FORBES, close to the pace about the three path, faded on the first turn and was through early.
