Footnotes

ADRASTEAS rated close to the early pace two deep, rallied to the front near the five sixteenths pole, edged away from there and held well with steady stretch handling. BREEZY ARCH eased outward through the opening turn to settle off the pace outside, gave chase from the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn five wide and finished evenly for place. BRIGADE FLAG, off the pace and off the rail, eased out with a bid from the half mile pole, rounded the final turn in the three path then leveled out down the lane. SILK MOVES, well back toward mid track, bid from the five sixteenths pole then leveled off through the lane. TAPS LADY rated close to the early pace off the rail, gave chase leaving the seven sixteenths pole, improved her position in the three path of the final turn then weakened down the lane. BABE A LISCIOS saved ground well off the pace. SCARY CARI moved clear for the rail early to show the way inside, came under pressure past the three eighths pole, was caught a pole further on then faded rounding the final turn. DAENERYS was no factor and eased on the final turn.
