Footnotes

TORI'S BREEZE moved to a slim lead two deep at the nine sixteenths pole, rated her speed through most of the backstretch, was pressured from the five sixteenths pole, driven into the lane and dug in under determined handling to last. COULD BE A RUMOR dropped back from a brief early lead inside to stalk the winner, eased off the rail with a bid into the stretch, couldn't match strides with that one and just lasted for place. MY REWARD settled off the pace off the rail, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, eased five wide through the final turn, finished well and just missed place. EVENINGOFPLEASURE settled off the pace inside, bid near the five sixteenths pole, closed the gap through the final turn, eased four wide into the lane and finished evenly. GLENORIE challenged the winner two deep leaving the first turn, dueled from the five sixteenths pole and held aim to the head of the lane before leveling off. MISTY'S SONG rated close about the three path, gave chase from the quarter pole then weakened in the stretch. PENSAO settled back toward mid track, made a bid from the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn in the six path then weakened in the lane. WATSUP QUEEN lost ground into the first turn and never factored. TICKLE TRUNK kept close to the pace about the five path, gave chase from the three eighths pole but faded on the final turn.
