GRAVEL GERTIE stalked the pace three wide, dropped to the rail on the turn, finished strongly. MARY CARLISLE prompted the pace three and four wide, finished well. DALIA DOLLY pressed the pace three wide, finished willingly. BACA advanced four wide, finished with good energy. PEACOMB HEN within striking distance three wide, lacked a closing bid. T. V. SECRETARY forced the pace four wide, lacked a late response.
