AH DAY bumped at the start, pressed the pace outside VIKRANT, sat in perfect position on the turn, was herded out into the stretch, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth pole then exchanged brushes with VIKRANT in late stretch. VIKRANT set the pace while kept three wide, drifted out into the stretch, exchanged brushes with the winner in late stretch. TACTICAL BRUSH bore out and bump with SHOULDABEENACLOWN at the start, forced the issue inside, came three wide around the turn and finished well. GUYS NITE OUT prompted the leaders along the rail, lacked a closing bid. KING COHL stalked the pace inside, failed to respond. NITTYGRITYDIRTBEAR saved ground to no avail. SHOULDABEENACLOWN bumped and then in tight at the start, never was a factor, four wide.
