Footnotes

PIVOTAL MOMENT set a pressured pace, hugged the rail through the stretch and drew off under urging. BOBBLEY circled horses leaving the backstretch, chased the winner in a game effort but was second best. LE DELUGE , fractious behind the starting gate, lacked speed, circled foes entering the stretch and rallied. MR. APPOMATTOX , three wide both turns, passed tired rivals. TALK TO THE KING chased the pace, raced in the two path entering the far turn and weakened through the stretch. HABOUR SHARK , high headed early, raced along the rail entering the stretch and passed tired foes. MEMORABLE DISPUTE raced in the middle of the pace and failed to rally. DILLDINE , checked in tight quarters entering the first turn, rushed up along the rail entering the backstretch, remained prominent to the far turn then gave way. RICHNCHARMING was outrun. PASS THE CASH dropped back on the backstretch and was pulled up on the far turn.
