MOLINARO HONOR settled off the early pace off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole, moved to even terms midway on the final turn, drifted out past the three sixteenths pole, entered the stretch about the five path but dug in from there to take over and draw clear from the sixteenth pole then kept to steady encouragement to widen. MONEY ISSUES, well back off the rail, bid approaching the quarter pole, eased to the four path leaving the final turn and closed with a late rush to get place under the wire. BY YOUR SIDE, reluctant to load, quickly took over a clear lead inside, was pressured from the three eighths pole, dug in to the winner's challenge and kept a slim advantage through the upper stretch before yielding. LEVITE, off the early pace off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole, improved through the final turn and finished evenly. UNUSUAL LAZ rated close to the early pace off the rail, bid at the three eighths pole, improved through the final turn and finished evenly. BAY BUTTON BILL, off the early pace about the three path, closed the gap to mid turn but leveled off in the lane. HEFFERMAN raced well back.
