Footnotes

TODAY AND ALWAYS rated a clear lead inside, was pressured into the stretch and held well under a steady drive. NICK'S MONSTER settled back about the three path, bid from the five sixteenths pole and duelled for place in midstretch. AWESOME DAVID was carried out entering the first turn, rated off the pace toward the inside, gave chase leaving the half mile pole then leveled off at the rail on the final turn. QUICK SHOW, well back in the three path, made a mild bid saving ground past the three eighths pole but leveled off rounding the final turn. SIGNAL FLAG steadied early and raced well back inside. VIRGINIA GENTLEMAN stalked the early pace off the rail then faded through the backstretch. ROCKINGLENROY lost some ground entering the first turn, quickly moved to the inside near the nine sixteenths pole but gave way after three eighths.
