FORTUNATELY BOLD off pace five wide down the backstretch, rallied six wide around the turn coming nine wide into the lane, closed with a rush to be up on the wire. BLAZING BENTLEY prompted the issue from the inside, swung out four wide on the turn, made a slim lead nearing the sixteenth pole then missed on the wire. JOSHUA LIGHTHEART reserved three and four wide for a half, launched his bid around the turn, loomed boldly into the stretch and finished strongly. SEEKING THE CASH saved ground, steadily moved up to come four wide on the turn, became prominent on the turn but failed to sustain his bid in the lane. YANKEE DOODLE BOY hit the gate at the start, saved ground throughout and finished with good energy through the stretch. JOEL'S TOUCH pressed the pace four wide down the backstretch, dropped to the inside around the turn, lacked a closing bid. PSYCHOTIC REACTION set the pace while kept three wide along the backstretch, eased down to the rail on the turn, weakened in the drive. STORMIN BULL forced the issue four wide, angled to the rail around the turn, faded through the stretch. BASTILE LAD used up after a half, four wide.
