JUDGE PRIEST bore out and bumped with PETER G at the start, pressed the issue from the inside, gained a slim lead at the top of the stretch then was all out to last. KAUFY DREAMMACHINE saved ground, rallied three wide on the turn and finished well. SILKEN MANNER set the pace on the rail, dug in around the turn, weakened the last sixteenth. DEALER three wide down the backstretch, dropped to the rail on the turn, finished strongly. VOTE YES FOR LOVE off a step slow then in tight at the start, was three and four wide, lacked a closing bid. WARRENSBURG prompted the pace three wide, lacked a late response. ROMAN CANDLE LIGHT bore out and bumped with JUDGE PRIEST at the start then was used up after a half along the inside. PETER G soundly bumped at the start, had little left after a half from the inside. SIR GUS veered out at the start, steadied then was no factor three wide. JACK OF HEARTS hopped at the start, was outrun three and four wide.
