KISS THE STARS , off the early pace, circled the turn, took the lead inside the eighth pole and narrowly prevailed under energetic urging. MADALYN'S CHOICE , three wide down the backstretch, prompted the pace, was two wide between horses leaving the turn, closed inside the winner and just missed in a sharp effort. BUSY SISTER set the pace in the two path down the backstretch, angled to the rail entering the turn and gave way in midstretch. TRUCKSTERS DANCE , two wide around the turn, lacked the needed rally. GO TO HEAVEN , no factor, passed tired rivals. STRIKING BELLA broke slowly, raced wide entering the stretch and lugged in near the sixteenth pole. COSTUME BALL broke slowly, swung wide leaving the turn and passed tired foes. MISS DEVIL HER DUE , inside horses on the turn, weakened. GARNER FAVOR was outrun. GLITTERING FIRE , sent early, hugged the rail, prompted the pace, was lightly steadied near the five sixteenths pole and stopped leaving the turn.
