A NICE CUPA TEA vied along the rail down the backstretch, drew off nearing the lane, continued on her left lead in the drive and held well clear. RESTLESS TOUCH chased the pace three wide and finished willingly to gain the place. CRAFTY MARY raced four wide around the turn and was along for show. LA CHUPACABRA failed to menace while racing two wide. AMBER'S DELIGHT dueled outside of the winner and tired nearing the lane. GRUMPSHERGRANNY steadied near the half-mile pole and was never a threat while racing two wide. GOLDEN BUTTERFLY saved ground to no avail. EMMY'S PEARL steadied near the half-mile pole and was no further factor while racing three wide.
