Footnotes

NEVER MINED rated back saving ground, bid leaving the half mile pole and steadily advanced to take over four wide in late stretch. REFLECTED AFFAIR settled close off the rail, bid toward the five sixteenths pole then outfinished in the stretch duel. SHAMSS rated close three wide, took aim leaving the five sixteenths pole and dug in a viable stretch factor to deep stretch before leveling off. SERGEANT SAXTON moved to a clear lead off the rail the opening turn, rated his speed to the three eighths pole, was pressured beyond that point, contested slim control through the final turn, edged clear into the lane but was caught in deep stretch. CHRISTMAS HOLLADAY dropped well back to save ground, eased out leaving the final turn but leveled off in the stretch. I GOT'M was not a factor while saving ground. DANCING VALIANT stalked the early pace two deep, gave chase from the three eighths pole but faded after a half mile. KINSTAR, off the early pace two deep, gave chase nearing the three eighths pole then gave way toward the final turn.
