**Footnotes**

FAMILY CHIEF, six wide into the opening turn, rated close outside, bid five wide leaving the five sixteenths pole and dug in from the top of the stretch to inch ahead the final yards. BUBBA DE FRANCE stalked the early pace two deep, moved to a brief lead inside the three eighths pole, was immediately caught past the pole, gave chase from there to take over again into the stretch but was outfinished the final yards. MCKENZIE rated close about the three path, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, dueled to the front past the three eighths pole, contested a slim advantage through the final turn but dropped back into the stretch and leveled off from the sixteenth pole. BOOGITY BOOG kept off the pace off the rail, bid toward the five sixteenths pole, angled four wide leaving the final turn then leveled off in the stretch. MICKEY MAC'S TURN, blocked near the rail the opening turn, gave chase into the backstretch, lost some ground on the final turn, entered the stretch about the five path and finished evenly outside. WICKLIFFE MAN rounded the opening turn about the six path, settled back toward mid track, saved some ground on the final turn and ran evenly down the lane. DAYLIGHT STREAKER moved to the front three wide at the nine sixteenths pole, dueled with a slim advantage to the three eighths pole then faded approaching the final turn. SILVER PIONEER eased outward the opening turn, gave distant chase outside then weakened widest on the final turn. WOODYS A GOODIE ran out into the opening turn and never factored outside. GOBLIN'S GHOST had a short lead inside the opening turn, yielded control at the nine sixteenths pole, gave chase from there then gave way approaching the final turn.
