LAMUIM advanced to the front while angling in, rated a short lead inside, was pressured at the five sixteenths pole, contested a slim advantage through the final turn and dug in determinedly down the lane to discourage the challenge of Operative. OPERATIVE stalked the pace off the rail, started his bid at the five sixteenths pole, contested a slim disadvantage through the final turn, dropped back in the upper stretch but came back gamely nearing the wire. TIP OF THE SWORD, well back toward mid track, gave chase leaving the half mile pole, rounded the final turn five wide and dueled late for show. PREMIER'S WHINNY settled off the pace in the three path, bid from the five sixteenths pole, had aim rounding the final turn, leveled off down the lane then outfinished in the duel for show. PRIVATE NOTICE chased the pace off the rail, lost ground on the final turn, entered the stretch four wide and leveled off from there. A. P. BEST saved ground. LIFASI rated back toward mid track, made a mild middle bid down the backstretch though showed nothing further in the stretch. PRIDE OF MARY gave chase inside but was through after three eighths.
