DEVILS SYMPATHY set the pace on the rail, drew off around the turn, remained clear under urging. ROCK OUT prompted the issue three wide, finished strongly. STOCKTON BAD BEN stalked the leaders three wide, lacked a closing bid. JUNIOR V. saved ground, lacked a late response. BISHOP WILL pressed the pace just off the rail, tired. BANDINI ACE made little impact along the inside. TONIGHTSAGOODNIGHT bore in and soundly bumped with MAJOR MAX at the start, never was a factor four and five wide. MAJOR MAX soundly bumped at the start, never threatened four and five wide. BIG MISSY STEEL off slow, showed little on the rail. MESCALERO AGAVE hit the gate at the start, rushed to contention, stopped after a half.
