PENGUIN HEART settled back off the rail, started a bid past the five sixteenths pole, steadily improved through the final turn, dug in for the lead in the upper stretch and widened to the wire. MY SWEET LILY rated with the early pace two deep, worked her way to the front past the five eighths pole, was pressured a furlong later, edged clear saving ground into the final turn, driven past the three sixteenths pole but caught in the upper stretch and leveled off from there. TO MY SURPRISE rated back toward the inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, lost momentum on the heels of the waning Red Catherine leaving the final turn, eased around that one into the lane and finished evenly to show. RED CATHERINE set the early pace inside, dropped back to stalk the runner-up from the five eighths pole, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole then leveled off at the rail into the stretch. TEQUILA N' LIME, well back off the rail, gave chase from the three eighths pole, angled widest through the final turn, lost more ground into the lane and showed nothing further. PAST YOUR EYES was kept in range of the early pace about the three path, gave chase leaving the first turn then faded rounding the final turn. TRUCKSTERS DANCE was not a factor. KENNEDY CAT was no factor while mostly saving ground. BLUES ATTITUDE was through early.
