

Footnotes

HELP A BROTHER accelerated to the front inside at the five sixteenths pole, was driven into the lane and steadily encouraged to widen. BOPSICLE chased the winner from the inside, proved no match for that one and settled for second best. FOREVER BLESSING chased the pace inside, was shut off steadying past the five sixteenths pole, eased outward through the turn, entered the stretch in the three path and finished evenly for show. I'M ALL SPOTTED UP chased the early pace off the rail, moved to the inside past the five sixteenths pole then weakened in the stretch. GONE BEFORE LONG wheeled losing his rider behind the gate then gave distant chase toward mid track. ANOTHER INVESTMENT gave chase two deep after a brief early lead but lost ground leaving the turn and weakened from there. CLICKIT OR TRICKIT was outrun in an even effort off the rail then passed tiring rivals widest. BANNER TIME dropped well back outside. BY A LANDSLIDE saved ground.
