GO MAIRE TU stalked the pace off the rail, took aim leaving the three eighths pole, dueled to a slim lead past the five sixteenths pole, drew clear on the final turn and widened under steady handling. LIAM'S SONG, unhurried inside, bid near the five sixteenths pole, eased four wide through the final turn and reached place in the upper stretch. OCASTA rated close to the early pace inside, gave chase from the half mile pole, eased three wide on the final turn but leveled off down the lane. WILD AND WILEY, well back inside, bid at the rail from the quarter pole and finished evenly to pass tiring rivals. HOT ESCAPADE moved clear for inside position heading into the first turn, rated the pace to the three eighths pole, was caught and gave chase from that point then weakened in the stretch. FRED HIGH was not a factor. MONZON rated close to the early pace in the three and four paths, bid from the three eighths pole but showed nothing further on the final turn. BLIMEY settled close about the three path but had no further response after three quarters.
