

## HOLLYWOOD CASINO AT CHARLES TOWN RACES - June 30, 2012 - Race 8

THE FIFTH RUNNING OF THE LADY CHARLES TOWN. Fillies Three Years Old. Free nominations. Nominations close

Wednesday, June 20, 2012. \$250 to pass the entry box, with a purse of \$75,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 7th through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Supplemental nominations of \$5,000 due at time of entry, all fees included. Weight: 121 lbs.

Non-winners of \$22,000 in 2012 allowed 3 lbs., a race other than maiden or claiming in 2012 allowed 5 lbs. Field will be limited to ten starters with four on the alternates list. Preference to stakes winners in order (Grade I, Grade II, Grade III), then stakes winners, then highest lifetime earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to owner of winner.

### Footnotes

DOE set the pace along the rail, took heavy pressure around the far turn, responded when roused nearing the eighth pole to edge back ahead and slowly widened under confident handling while continuing on her left lead through the lane. JAZZY IDEA stalked the pace inside around the first turn, eased out to advance down the backstretch, steadily gained on the winner from the three-eighths pole to reach even terms by the three-sixteenths marker, vied outside to upper stretch and was turned back while holding well clear for the place. MOON PHILLY settled off the pace along the rail, advanced into third while continuing to save ground around the far turn and finished evenly in the lane to maintain that position. PROUD PEARL bumped with HARD MYSTERY just after the start, was unhurried while racing three wide around the first turn, went four wide around the far turn and lacked a rally. DANGEROUS VIXEN stalked the pace three wide and came up empty around the far turn. RITA HAYWOOD was outrun while racing three wide. HARD MYSTERY bumped with PROUD PEARL just after the start and was no further factor while racing three and four wide. SUPER QUIET was off a bit slow, raced four wide throughout, tired and was eased.
