**Footnotes**

STAR CITY EXPRESS , three wide on the turns, opened a clear lead midway on the final bend, bumped SEASONALITY when drifting out in deep stretch and lasted. UNBRUSH lacked speed, was wide around the far turn, rallied and was bumped by SEASONALITY in deep stretch. SEASONALITY , three wide on the turns, eased out to the four path entering the stretch, closed ground and was bumped and forced out by STAR CITY EXPRESS in deep stretch. INCRIVAL VENCEDOR saved ground the first turn, was two wide the far turn, eased out in upper stretch and flattened out between horses. DOUBLE MOCA set the pace along the rail and gave way in the drive. PASSING LANE lacked speed, failed to menace and passed tired foes. ACROSS THE WIND was not a factor. LYCIAN prompted the pace two wide and faltered. LUCK OF THE DREW unseated his rider and ran off twice during the post parade, hugged the rail and faltered after three furlongs. Following an objection by the rider of SEASONALITY, STAR CITY EXPRESS was disqualified and placed third. An objection by the rider of SEASONALITY against UNBRUSH for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed.
