LADY GREEN set the pace while just off the rail, held a clear lead into the stretch then was under strong urging at the end to prevail. SONG OF A CAT pressed the issue three wide, moved to the winner in the stretch but could not get by while all out to hold second. ICY AND CIVIL forced the pace from the rail, angled out some for the drive and finished well. CAT NIP KITTY broke awkwardly, advanced along the inside, finished strongly through the lane. OLYMPIAS GOLD stalked the leaders from the rail, finished with good energy through the stretch. PASSING VIRTUES failed to menace, four and five wide. FAINT SHADOW made little impact, three and four wide. FOREVER TO BE showed little from the inside. HUG THE ROCK flashed brief foot, three wide. C. M. WINGS hopped at the start then trailed three and four wide.
