Footnotes

YELLATTHEMINISTER , three wide entering the first turn, moved up in the two path entering the backstretch, prompted the pace outside HEY DOC HOLIDAY , gained a short lead leaving the backstretch, drifted in when barely clear near the sixteenth pole then held on late. WESTERN FRONTIER , two wide, was put to the whip near the five sixteenths pole, eased out to the three path in upper stretch and rallied late. HEY DOC HOLIDAY set a pressured pace along the rail, weakened in upper stretch and was steadied on the heels of YELLATTHEMINISTER near the sixteenth pole. YOU SAY BOLT saved ground in an even effort. EVICTOR lacked speed and passed tired rivals. TAPIOCA PUDDING , swung wide entering the stretch, passed tired foes and drifted in late. THE FENIAN WARRIOR , three wide entering the far turn, stopped. MATTHEW'S PRIDE , steadied after bobbling at the break, raced three wide entering the first turn and faltered. ZIPPY CAT RULES dropped back.
