Footnotes

MOJAVE'S GOLD tardy at the start, moved up four and five wide, was set down for the drive and up in the final strides. FACE UP stalked the leaders three and four wide, gained a brief lead in deep stretch but missed. TYRAE forced the pace three and four wide, had aim into the stretch but was out finished. DOC THUNDERBOLT prompted the issue three wide, angled to the rail on the turn, held a clear lead on the turn, led until nearing the sixteenth pole before weakening. HIDDEN SOURCE off a step slow, failed to menace three and four wide. GOLDEN RETIREMENT up close along the rail, stopped after three quarters. CHANCE'S STORM set the pace on the rail, had little left after six furlongs. HOYA BLUE made little impact from the rail.
