Footnotes

AVERY'S ANGEL rated back off the rail, bid nearing the three eighths pole, saved ground on the final turn, dueled to the front midstretch and drew clear past the sixteenth pole. CAMMY MOUNTAIN rated a short lead inside, was urged away past the three eighths pole, dug in from the top of the lane and held the advantage to midstretch before giving way. WINCHESTER CAT rated close toward mid track, started a bid at the five sixteenths pole but leveled off down the lane. ANTHENSOME, well back about the three path, bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased six wide through the final turn and had little left in the lane. M M DINNER raced well back off the rail and had no rally. PARKER'S CAT settled close to the early pace outside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn five wide then weakened in the stretch. STEALING MONEY settled close to the early pace about the three path, started a bid leaving the three eighths pole, saved some ground on the final turn then weakened in the stretch. SYPHON THE MONEY rated with the early pace two deep but was through after a half mile.
