**Footnotes**

KOKO KEY stalked the pace about the three path, started his bid past the three eighths pole, dueled to the front in the upper stretch and kept to a steady drive to widen. RUNNING RACCOON rated the pace inside, contested the rail through the final turn, yielded control past the eighth pole and leveled out from there. TIME IS NOW was kept in range off the rail to the three eighths pole, gave chase beyond that point but faded approaching the final turn. WIN THE GREEN rated just off the early pace toward mid track though faded after a half mile. DEVIL CAREER was no factor while well back. NOT FOR GRANTED, awkward at the break, lost some ground into the first turn, moved to the inside past the nine sixteenths pole and saved ground from there. IMYOURHUCKLEBERRY raced well back inside and was vanned off post race.
