**Footnotes**

SILVER SPELL rushed clear to rate the pace inside, came under pressure toward the quarter pole and dug in to a hardy drive to hold on. BEAT THE SPREAD settled off the pace and off the rail, bid at the five sixteenths pole, gained mildly and finished evenly for place. BILL'S REPRIZED, well back off the rail, bid three wide nearing the quarter pole and finished evenly in show. TWELVE DEGREES came slightly inward after the break, rated back inside, gave chase leaving the first turn but proved empty down the lane. GOLD GLOVE, pinched back after the break, settled well back toward the outside, bid nearing the quarter pole, rounded the final turn five wide and passed tiring rivals widest. BLACKBERRY WINTER steadied angling inward and made contact with Gold Glove shortly after the break then raced well back inside. JUDGE MARSHALL was outrun in mid track. BON APPETIT stalked the early pace off the rail, gave chase from the three eighths pole then faded toward the final turn. DISTINCT HONOR was never a factor. DON'T TAKE ME was eased up after a half mile and came back bleeding from the nose. After reviewing an objection lodged by the rider of Blackberry Winter, against the rider of Twelve Degrees, the stewards disqualified the latter to sixth place for interfering with the former leaving the gate which ultimately effected Gold Glove as well.
