Footnotes

RUSH ON was hustled clear to set the pace inside and remained under steady handling throughout. RUN PAIGE RUN gave chase from the inside and dueled for place before leveling off. JUST JAZZIN gave chase off the rail and ceded place in a stretch long duel. SMOKINDOWNTHELANE chased the early pace from the inside, eased out leaving the turn and finished evenly. CAFE RENDEZVOUS gave distant chase outside, left the turn eight wide and flattened out widest. JEAN'S DREAM chased the early pace well back and off the rail, angled six wide through the final turn then leveled off in mid track. CAT SPEAK gave distant chase toward the outside, rounded the turn seven wide and had nothing further through the lane. AFLEET CHILL chased the pace off the rail to the middle of the turn before fading.
