Footnotes

CLARKE COUNTY eased off the rail leaving the first turn, moved to the front approaching the three eighths pole, was pressured from the five sixteenths and held well with steady encouragement. MORNING LIGHT moved clear for the early lead to show the way inside, was caught nearing the three eighths pole, gave chase a pole late but could make no significant gain. FLIPFLOPSANDSOCKS, off the pace and off the rail, bid leaving the first turn and finished well. KING HARRY stalked the early pace in the three path, took aim past the three eighths pole and continued in close chase through the final turn before leveling off. ROCKTHENITEAWAY, well back early, made an outside bid from the half mile pole, rounded the final turn in the four path then proved empty down the lane. SENOR CAFE, off the pace in mid track, saved some ground while giving chase nearing the final turn then weakened in the stretch. GAGMAN, IN CONFIDENCE and SUAWE FOX were all not factors. DEVIL'S HALL, off the pace inside, was through early.
