COLLEGE STATION accelerated to the early lead, set the pace along the rail and prevailed under energetic urging. PRECIOUS HECKLE bobbled soon after the break, prompted the pace outside the winner and finished gamely. BUSY SISTER outside foes, raced three wide around the turn and closed the gap late. SHES UNFORGETTABLE , three wide on the turn, worked between horses and gained ground late. GOOD SONG , wide around the turn, lacked the necessary late response. SUMMER WIND BLUES , very wide entering the stretch, finished willingly. WAY POINT broke slowly, raced along the rail, was checked in tight quarters entering the turn and failed to launch the needed response. GENE'S REALITY hugged the rail and gave way entering the turn. CAT SPEAK , no factor, was outrun. LAUGH TIL I CRY , off the rail, dropped back.
