### Footnotes

TOMORROW'S TALE stalked the early pace off the rail, moved to the front two deep nearing the five sixteenths pole, urged clear on the final turn, drifted out entering the stretch but dug in and held on well when straightened away. TWENTY HAWKS stalked the pace off the rail, bid three wide leaving the seven sixteenths pole, angled inside the drifting winner to take aim at the head of the lane but leveled off the final sixteenth. TIME FOR ATONEMENT held a short lead inside the opening turn, was caught and gave chase from the five sixteenths pole but faded on the final turn. COLONEL J W rated off the pace inside, made a bid toward the three eighths pole then faded rounding the final turn. PROUD OF MIDWAY was through after a half mile.
