HOUSEHUNTER set all the pace on the rail, drew off around the turn, remained clear while kept to steady urging. T. M.'S TREASURE saved ground, rallied four wide on the turn, closed with a rush through the stretch. STAR MONEY prompted the issue three wide, finished strongly. PROSECCA pressed the pace just off the rail, lacked a late response. DANCED ALL NIGHT forced the issue from the rail, failed to respond when asked in the lane. BREW CREW three and four wide, failed to menace. ARDAGH stalked the leaders three and four wide, tired. HASTA LA PASTA four wide down the backstretch, angled to the rail on the turn, never threatened in the drive.
