Footnotes

GANGA forced the issue four wide, inherited the lead when WINDSOR CITY was carried wide into the stretch then drove clear. WINDSOR CITY set the pace just off the rail, was carried wide into the stretch by the rider less horse and was second best. PREMIER'S WHINNY prompted the issue three wide, lacked a closing bid. SOUND AFFAIR pressed the pace just off the rail, lacked a late response. SANSAR MOUNTAIN off a step slow, never threatened three wide. BIG ROUGE tardy then bumped at the start, never was a factor along the inside. TURF KING five wide around the first turn, was three and four wide thereafter, made little impact. STARCASM saved ground to no avail. ADAM'S INTRO bore out and bumped with BIG ROUGE at the start, showed little three wide. JJALAD stumbled then lost his rider at the start.
