Footnotes

NO BRAKES allowed to settle off the pace, began his rally three wide down the backstretch, was set down for the drive and under a strong drive was up in the final strides. FRED HIGH well positioned off the dueling leaders three and four wide, gained the lead just off the rail around the turn, dug in when challenged through the stretch, leading until the final strides. LIVELY REPARATIONS set the pace under strong pressure from the inside, was still a factor on the turn, raced evenly through the stretch. SILENT SHOT off the pace saving ground, swung out four wide for the drive but lacked a closing bid when asked in the lane. GHOSTLY THUNDER stalked the leaders from the inside, failed to respond when asked in the stretch. PREACHIN HEAT pressed the issue three wide, stopped after three quarters.
