NORTHERN LINKAGE advanced three wide, gained the lead down the backstretch to draw well clear while angling to the rail, remained clear through the stretch under a drive. PARADO off a step slow, moved up four and five wide to be second best. FLASHY BOO stalked the leaders three wide, bid six wide around the turn and finished willingly. JUDGE MARSHALL trailed for a half, rallied along the rail on the turn and finished well. SUMMERLAND forced the leaders from the rail, lacked a late response. INFIELD set the pace on the rail, eased out three wide on the turn, gave way in the drive. DIAMOND PARK never threatened five and six wide. KALIK MON made little impact, three and four wide. TALENTED PROSPECT flashed early speed from the inside, steadily fell back.
