### Footnotes

SULTRY PROSPECTOR stalked the pace from the rail around the first turn, eased out nearing the half-mile pole, bid two wide between rivals nearing the far turn, reached even terms near the quarter pole, dueled outside of BLUESIDE from there to deep stretch and prevailed. BLUESIDE set the pace along the rail, dueled inside of the winner from the quarter pole to deep stretch, continued on his left lead in the lane and gave way late. SAND AND STONE tracked the pace two and three wide, moved into third while no match for the top two around the far turn, continued on his left lead in the lane and held on for the show. TUMULTUOUS saved ground early, raced three wide around the far turn and improved his position. ROADHOUSE ROMEO failed to menace while racing two wide around the first turn and five wide around the far turn. PLEASANT GALLOP never factored while racing two wide. CUSTIS faded four wide. TWO STEP B never factored while racing two wide. ESTRELLA CORREDOR stalked the pace three wide and tired around the far turn. AMAZON SWINGER prompted the pace two wide and was done early.
