Footnotes

ALLEN DID IT rated with the pace off the rail, took aim near the five sixteenths pole, dueled to the front midway on the final turn, lugged in a path through the upper stretch then promptly widened when straightened away. DONTMESSWITHALLEN rated a slim lead inside, was pressured leaving the five sixteenths pole, yielded the advantage midway on the final turn, was checked while in tight at the rail in midstretch and leveled off from there. FEEL MY PRESENCE rated close inside, gave chase past the three eighths pole and finished evenly. RAGGEDY PEAK stalked the pace about the three path, had aim three wide at the three eighths pole and gave close chase through the final turn before weakening. BUY MY COMMISSARY settled back about the three path, made a four wide bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole but leveled off in the stretch. BUBBA BEAR, outside and well back, made a mild bid from the five sixteenths pole then saved some ground on the final turn. RAVENS TERMS was not a factor while saving ground. COLEMAN BARRICKS rounded the first turn in the five path, gave chase in mid track but weakened after a half mile. ELDER JOHN was through early. After a stewards inquiry, the winning horse was disqualified to second for lugging in on the runner-up in midstretch, causing that one to check.
