Footnotes

WINK AT THE GIRLS stalked the pace off the rail, dueled to the lead past the quarter pole, briefly yielded the lead while in an outward drift in the upper stretch but dug in under determined handling to regain control and just lasted. MEDAGLIA'S IMAGE, well back toward the outside, started a bid nearing the quarter pole, saved some ground on the final turn, eased five wide in the upper stretch, lugged slightly in late but finished well and just missed. SANDBAGIN' LOVER stalked the pace off the rail, made a four wide bid near the quarter pole, closed well to midstretch but was shuffled back steady near the wire. NOAH'S HARVEST rated close inside, gave chase from the five sixteenths pole, was boxed at the heels of the top two in the upper stretch but finished well when clear. LOVE TO THE MAX rated a slim lead inside, was prompted nearing the five sixteenths pole, caught midway on the final turn, came out making contact with the winner in the upper stretch, briefly regained the upper hand in midstretch but gave way soon after. LIVE THE DASH, off the pace and off the rail, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, entered the stretch five wide and leveled off from there. MANDATUM, four wide the opening turn, was kept off the pace toward the outside, gave chase nearing the five sixteenths pole but showed little further on the final turn. A stewards inquiry of the incident in the upper stretch, resulted in no change. A claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of the third place finisher, also resulted in no change.
