LOVE TO THE MAX pressed the issue on the rail, gained a slim lead in the upper stretch and was all out to last. CASEY DOON made a slim lead down the backstretch, dug in around the turn, missed in a strong effort. LIVELY UP YOURSELF with the pace three wide, angled to the rail on the turn, finished strongly. THIS BIDS FOR YOU stalked the leaders four wide, failed to respond. PROPER JAZZ rank at the start, failed to menace three wide. JOY TO THE LIGHT forced the pace between horses, lacked a late response. MAKIN A HIT off a step slow, was no factor on the rail. DIAMOND MINER bobbled at the start, showed little four wide. STORM WITH PRAISE trailed, three wide.
