OZ prompted the issue from the rail and while unable to gain on the winner was all out to hold second. RICH MARCHESA bumped at the start, was with the leaders three wide but was no match for the winner in the drive. ICY AND CIVIL pressed the pace just off the rail, lacked a closing bid. MOLLIE LIL GIRL five wide first around the turn, moved to the rail along the backstretch, came wide on the last turn while no threat. YETTAS SUNSHINE bore in and bumped with RICH MARCHESA at the start, stalked the leaders from the inside, failed to respond. FOREVER TO BE up close early, was used up after a half. C. M. WINGS tardy at the start, trailed three and four wide.
