CITIGAMBLER chased the pace off the rail, dueled to the front past the quarter pole, drew clear midstretch and widened to the wire. PURR DIN ALICE hustled clear to set the pace inside, was caught past the quarter pole and loomed a close presence to midstretch before giving way. BREW FOR THE BAND, well back toward the outside, rounded the turn five wide, finished well and was gaining on the runner-up. BIG CHAMP gave close early chase outside, faded on the turn then leveled off down the lane. D J'S LADIES MAN, briefly close, chased the pace toward mid track and finished evenly. EL FLACO chased the pace inside then faded on the turn. EASTER JELLY BEAN chased the pace off the rail then weakened through the lane. LAW'S HILL came away awkwardly and was steadied early.
