Footnotes

JENKIN JONES lacked speed, hugged the rail, was put to the whip approaching the three eighths pole, eased off the rail entering the far turn, was steadied when blocked near the three sixteenths pole, found room in the three path between horses in upper stretch, closed and proved best. ALBERS stalked the duel, moved up three wide between horses on the far turn, drifted to the four path when gaining a short lead near the eighth pole then flattened out. ICE BERLIN lacked speed, saved ground, angled to the five path at the head of the lane and rallied. ROCK N' BID , four wide around the far turn, bid for the lead entering the stretch and weakened in the drive. FORTUNATE STORM saved ground, disputed the pace and weakened. HUBBERT'S PEAK dueled two wide and weakened in the drive. INODINO , three wide on both turns, was outrun.
