GHOSTLY THUNDER lacked speed, advanced well off the rail entering the far turn, swung wide leaving the final bend, closed and was along in time. SON OF A BEAR , three wide both turns, chased the pace, bumped with PAGAN CAT when challenging for the lead near the eighth pole, lugged in near the sixteenth pole and weakened. PAGAN CAT , two wide both turns, chased the pace, bumped with SON OF A BEAR when bidding for the lead in upper stretch and flattened out in the drive. TROUBLE MAKIN assumed the early lead, set the pace along the rail and gave way. EVENING CONCERTO , three wide both turns, was not a factor. TAYLOR'S FLIGHT , rated back approaching the first turn, was checked entering the first turn, saved ground and weakened. DIXIE THIEF lacked speed and trailed.
