Footnotes

GREAT VINTAGE pressed the issue just off the rail, gained the lead on the turn, drew off through the stretch while under a drive. IN CONFIDENCE moved up three and four wide and was second best late. MIGHTY RUMBLE set the pace under heavy pressure but was no match for the winner in the drive. VOTE YES FOR LOVE bumped at the start, advanced three and four wide but never threatened in the drive. LE DELUGE bumped at the start, passed tiring rivals five wide. BOPING ALONG broke awkwardly and bumped with VOTE YES FOR LOVE at the start, was five wide for a half then had little left for the drive. BIG BIG STAR made little impact from the inside. HAWKSBUURY CROSSING was no factor three wide. TAKE PRIDE PLEASE saved ground to no avail. STORMIN' YANKEE bore out and bumped with LE DELUGE at the start, stopped after a half along the rail.
