LORD DUBAI three wide down the backstretch, rallied just off the rail through the stretch to be up in the final strides. OUR HONOR advanced five and six wide, closed with a rush through the lane. MISS KELSEY G alternated for the lead from the inside, led until deep stretch. IVANTSOFF moved up three and four wide, finished strongly. A NEW YODELER alternated on the lead three wide, dug in stretch, weakened the last sixteenth. SLATON prompted the issue four wide, finished well. BREW FOR THE BAND within striking distance along the rail, finished with good energy. BALLEEN ISLE four and five wide, finished willingly. BASHA'S MOON off slow, was three wide along the backstretch, dropped to the rail on the turn, lacked a closing bid. CHALK ONE sluggish at the start, trailed on the rail.
