### Footnotes

BIGUM stalked the pace, eased out three wide leaving the second turn, secured command near the three and a half furlongs pole, opened up along the rail on the far turn and was kept to his business in the stretch. RASCAL CAT lacked speed, circled rivals on the final turn and rallied. WILD PROOF disputed the pace two wide and weakened. ITINERIS , unhurried, eased out leaving the final turn and rallied belatedly. DELAWARE DIAMOND lacked speed, moved up between horses entering the final turn then failed to sustain his bid. REFLECTED AFFAIR , no factor, lost ground on all turns. GUSKA'S GOLD had speed along the rail and faltered on the far turn. NO COLLEEN , steadied on the first turn, was a factor for a half mile then gave way.
