GO IN set the pace along the inside, rated well down the backstretch, drew off around the turn and through the stretch under a steady drive. MELEIUM moved up just off the rail to be second best. VICTORY PEAK stalked the pace three and four wide, failed to respond. BIBELOT well placed on the rail, had no rally when it counted in the lane. NO NO RENE prompted the pace three and four wide, lacked a closing bid. SPEEDS THE KEY well positioned inside, lacked the needed late rally. SARATOGA SOFT SHOE pressed the pace for three quarters before fading. PRINTERS COMET was no factor three wide. JUST A LIL ROYAL reared at the start, showed little. LAST SHOOT OUT five wide on the backstretch, could not keep pace, pulled up in mid stretch then walked off after the finish.
