ALLIE'S THE BOSS settled off the early pace about the four path, started a bid leaving the five sixteenths pole and dug in under determined handling to win the nod under the wire. GET GLUED ON rated a short lead off the rail, was urged clear past the quarter pole, lugged slightly in making things tight for Maggy Mac midstretch, dug in gamely when straightened away but outfinished by a nod. MAGGY MAC rated off the pace inside, started her bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased outward through the final turn, angled in to come between horses past the eighth pole, steadied in tight at the rail midstretch but finished well. PLEASANT ASPECT lost ground into the first turn, settled well back off the rail, bid leaving the half mile pole, rounded the final turn in the four path then leveled off through the stretch. CREDIT RISK was kept off the early pace about the three path and showed little response through the backstretch. MY GORGEOUS was carried out entering the first turn and not a factor. STORMDEFRERE rated close to the pace inside, gave chase at the rail past the quarter pole, started to weaken leaving the final turn, was shut off past the eighth pole and not encouraged further. The stewards reviewed a claim of foul, lodged by the rider of the third place finisher, against the rider of the runner-up, and disqualified the runner-up for making things tight in midstretch.
