

Footnotes

RED GATE, bumped soundly at the break, rated with the pace inside, was urged to the front toward the three eighths pole, maintained a slim advantage through the final turn and dug in to draw clear midstretch. WINNERTAKESITALL drew to a clear early lead for inside position, rated with the winner two deep from the three eighths pole, contested at a slim disadvantage rounding the final turn, dropped back past the eighth pole but held on well for place. TIZ FRIDAY bobbled and was pinched back a stride from the gate, settled back from the pace off the rail, made an outside bid at the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn four wide then leveled off down the lane. ROCCAMO broke in making sharp contact with the winner after the start, settled off the pace off the rail, bid leaving the half mile pole then leveled off down the lane. UPPITIZ saved ground off the pace and weakened after a half mile. CROWDER rounded the opening turn in the five path, gave chase about the three path through the backstretch and had nothing further on the final turn. LABONTE rounded the opening turn about the six path and proved no factor.
