DESPINAS DESIRE rated off the early pace off the rail, eased outward rounding the first turn, started an outside bid from the seven sixteenths pole, saved ground to take over midway on the final turn and dug in under steady stretch handling to last. SHEA BALLETT, jostled at the start, was pinched back early, settled off the rail from the half mile pole, angled out with a bid from the seven sixteenths, came around the drifting Punch Like A Girl through the final turn, entered the stretch seven wide and got up late for place. FOREVER BLUE, well off the pace about the four path, bid leaving the three eighths pole, saved some ground on the final turn and took aim midstretch before leveling off. SERENE saved ground the opening turn, settled close off the rail, eased out with a bid nearing the quarter pole then drifted into the lane and leveled off from there. WICKEDLY BOLD broke in making contact with Shea Ballet, saved ground the opening turn, made a mild bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, had aim at the rail entering the stretch but leveled off. CASTLE'S GIRL, off the pace about the four path, bid past the half mile pole, moved to the front toward the quarter, was caught midway on the final turn and weakened through the lane. MISS WILKO broke out making contact with La Recoleta and never factored. PUNCH LIKE A GIRL rated with the pace two deep the opening turn, took a slim advantage leaving the seven sixteenths pole but proceeded to drift outward on the backstretch and weakened wide on the final turn. EPAMINONDA'S GIRL rated a slim lead inside the opening turn, was caught past the seven sixteenths pole though continued close chase through the backstretch before weakening. LA RECOLETTA ,bumped at the start, moved to the outside to settle off the pace and never factored widest.
